**Team Cally: Priorities 2011-12**

**This plan outlines the agreed priorities for Team Cally until November 2012, managed through the Team Cally Steering Group**

Priority	Actions
<p><b><i>Caledonian Road economic prosperity</i></b></p> <p>Begin a programme of work to revive the economic fortunes of the Caledonian Rd, attracting business uses and improving the retail and service offer</p>	<p>Run the Cally Festival as an all-year round activity focussed on an annual road-closure event; with smaller community events at key times such as Christmas, to increase the profile of the area, develop confidence in the community and bring in business</p> <p>Help traders and businesses on the Caledonian Rd to exercise leadership through the formation of a Traders' Association</p> <p>Make shops more accessible for traders and customers using vehicles by necessity – by reviewing current range of resident, pay &amp; display and business bays. Explore short-term parking for the use of traders and shoppers</p> <p>Use the Council's regulatory powers to improve the quality and behaviour of businesses: increase Trading Standards enforcement activity to reduce sales of alcohol to minors; help traders with small business rate relief; restrict further fast-food outlets and limit further licensed premises; enforce against sex trade premises.</p> <p>Work with landlords to encourage use of vacant shop units for temporary business uses</p> <p>Improve road safety and pedestrian security by reducing speed limit on Caledonian Road from 30mph to 20 mph and install a zebra crossing adjacent to Iceland store</p>
<p><b><i>Team Cally Community Hub</i></b></p> <p>Create a virtual community centre (or 'hub') for the ward from (initially) 5 existing community spaces. These are currently under-used and access to them is not consistent or clear.</p>	<p>Improve physical condition of community spaces</p> <p>Provide clear information available for local people about the community spaces available in the ward</p> <p>Provide clear information available as to how local groups and individuals can access and book community spaces</p> <p>Local community and voluntary groups are prioritised for bookings</p> <p>There are more community groups and services available in the ward that meet the needs of residents</p>
<p><b><i>Health and Wellbeing of Older People</i></b></p> <p>Improve the health and wellbeing of older people in the ward by contacting them at home and helping existing community organisations to reach out to them more effectively</p>	<p>Outreach work to older people in the ward delivered through South Islington Advice / Help on Your Doorstep contacts at least 100 vulnerable elderly people, some of whom may be housebound</p> <p>At least 20 vulnerable older people in the ward are supported through a 'Safe and Well' project</p> <p>6 community groups are given help in order that they can better reach out and help older people in the community</p>
